

# **EASY PATHWAY TO AUSTRALIAN LICENCE**

### Transfer International Motorcycle Licence to Queensland Motorcycle Licence

This is a pathway for those who are competent riders who know the road rules. If you are not competent or lacking in confidence, speak to us first.

# STEP 1

**Obtain a CRN Number -** Go to TMR (Transport & Main Roads) Service Centre to get a CRN (Customer Reference Number) and check your eligibility. Some countries are exempt from Steps 2 & 3. See list of exempt countries. To get a CRN you will need ID Documents together with proof of Qld residence + international licence and translation if necessary.

IMPORTANT: You are NOT applying for a licence at this time.

### **ID DOCUMENTS REQUIRED**

1 x Category A document 2 x Category B documents Proof of Qld residence – Document showing your Qld address

Passport (A)
Australian Bank Card (B)
Student ID (B)
Bank Statement (address)

#### **PLEASE NOTE**

All ID documents must be originals. At least one of the documents must show your signature. Digital version of proof of address acceptable.

# STEP 2

### **Enrol in a 1-day Q-Ride Motorcycle RE Restricted Course**

During the course you will need to demonstrate your competency and understanding of the road rules. The course can be done on a scooter, contact us for more information.

This course is up to 8 hours, and you must have some experience, be riding a motorcycle or scooter regularly in mainstream traffic conditions and be confident with cornering, low speed and braking control. The Restricted (RE) licence course consists of two components:

### **Q-Ride Exercises**:

Figure 8's – turn at a low speed with control
Slow Ride – control the bike at a slow walking pace
Slalom – weave around obstacles
Controlled stop – bring the bike to a smooth stop
Swerve – similar to slalom, however faster
Emergency stop – stop quickly and smoothly with total control

#### **Road Ride**

The 2 hour on-road session will combine both practical testing and discussion, to ensure you have the skills and knowledge to respond to potential hazards. The road ride will be in various speed zones up to 80km/hr and involve 5 x ten-minute rides and 5 x ten-minute discussions on defensive techniques.

## STEP 3

#### **Complete** Online Motorcycle Knowledge Test

You need to answer at least 27 out of 30 multiple choice questions correctly on topics ranging from road rules to risk management and hazard perception. With your CRN you can do this test online.

# STEP 4

#### Apply for your Qld Motorcycle licence at a TMR Customer Service Centre.

Once you have your Q-Ride Certificate and have completed the online Motorcycle Knowledge Test you can go into a TMR Customer Service Centre again and apply for and receive your Qld Motorcycle Licence.

NOTE: This is not a pathway to transfer your car licence. If you require a car licence, you can apply for a car learners licence and do an additional written and practical driving test.
